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Frequently Asked Questions

How does a tutoring session work?

Students simply indicate their grade, subject and topic area and get connected with a tutor in a desired subject within minutes. Students can also submit a paper to receive feedback from a tutor, and take practice quizzes.

How do I access the additional online resources?

The additional resources, including practice tests, study guides, worksheets, etc. are all accessible from the On-Demand Tutoring site. Most of these resources are stored in the SkillsCenter™ Library (a link off the main student dashboard) while practice tests are organized in their own tab off the main dashboard for easy navigation.

Are On Demand tutoring sessions recorded?

Yes, all tutoring sessions are recorded and transcribed for the students. The transcriptions and recordings can be accessed at any time by the student in the “My Sessions” section of the On-Demand Tutoring site.

How do you protect the safety of children/ students online?

Several measures are in place to protect the privacy and safety of all students:

- First, no personally identifiable information is shared.
- Second, all tutoring sessions are anonymous. Tutors do not know anything about the students other than what is entered into the tutoring request form (i.e. grade, subject, topic, specific questions, etc.).
- Third, students are in control as to how they choose to interact with a tutor. They can choose to text-chat only in the interactive classroom or voice-chat via telephone or computer audio. This selection is made by the student prior to starting each tutoring session.

Can a member request a favorite tutor for future sessions?

Yes, students have the option to tag their favorite tutors and schedule a session with them for a specific date and time.
